

Duckworth welcomes Illinois members of AIPAC to Washington to discuss national security priorities

WASHINGTON - U.S. Senator Tammy Duckworth (D-IL) addressed members of the American Israel Public Affairs Committee (AIPAC) who are in Washington, D.C., this week from Illinois for the 2017 AIPAC Policy Conference.
