


Rep. Bourne partners with First National Bank of Litchfield to host free shred event to prevent identity theft and fraud

SHRED TRUCK INSTRUCTIONS

- Follow traffic directional signs.
- Drivers should remain in their car while it is being unloaded by staff.
- Parking is available for those who want to watch document shredding.

State Representative **Avery Bourne** and the **First National Bank of Litchfield** are hosting a free paper shredding event. Two bags of paper documents per vehicle will be accepted for destruction. No electronics will be accepted for recycling or disposal.

LITCHFIELD - Representative Avery Bourne (R-Raymond) and First National Bank of Litchfield are partnering to host a free shred event at her district office on Saturday, June 10th. The event will take place from 9 a.m. to noon and all district residents are invited to bring their confidential documents, two bags maximum, to be shredded.

"Consumer fraud and identity theft are a growing problem in our communities," said Bourne. "This event is an effort to prevent this type of crime from happening. This is why I am encouraging are residents to come out and have their personal documents safely and securely destroyed at no charge."

Bourne's district office is located at 301 North Monroe Street in Litchfield. Cars will be directed to enter the parking lot across from the post office, on Monroe Street. Participants can leave their documents to be shredded on site or park in the lot while the shredding takes place. This free service is for residential, not business, shredding only and bags will be accepted until the trucks reach capacity.
