

Alton Closed Tennis Tourney features strong play in first night, finals Thursday

ALTON - The Alton Closed Tennis Tournament featured some outstanding play Tuesday night, Tourney Director Jesse Macias said.

In the men's open, Marquette is having a great tournament, Jesse Macias said.
