Glen-Ed Food Pantry Executive Director Judy Moody could not have been more pleased after receiving the generous donation from the field hockey team. The team also

collected more than 600 pounds of personal items and food from the Sept. 22 Stick Up For Hunger Game, now an embedded fall tradition for Edwardsville athletics.
