EDWARDSVILLE - Southern Illinois University Edwardsville senior Austin Tuttle, of Sherman, was recognized during the <u>Lincoln Academy</u> of Illinois' 43rd Annual Student Laureate Convocation on Saturday, Nov. 17 at the Old State Capitol in Springfield. The annual event honors one senior from each of the state's four-year, degree-granting colleges and universities for their excellence in curricular and extracurricular activities.

As one of the student laureates, the 21-year-old senior economics and finance major in the SIUE School of Business received a certificate of merit, an Order of Lincoln medallion and \$1,000 from The Lincoln Academy.
