



Stuart, Hoffman celebrate opening of road project

COLLINSVILLE – Last week, state Rep. Katie Stuart, D-Edwardsville, joined state Rep. Jay Hoffman, D-Swansea, Fairview Heights Mayor Mark Kupsky, and other local elected officials and residents to celebrate the completion and opening of a new cityscape in Fairview Heights.
