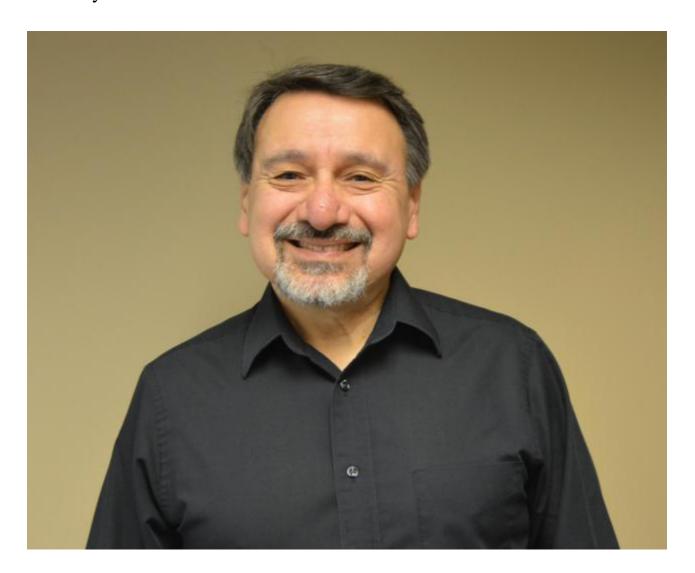


Great question to answer: What would you do if you weren't afraid?
