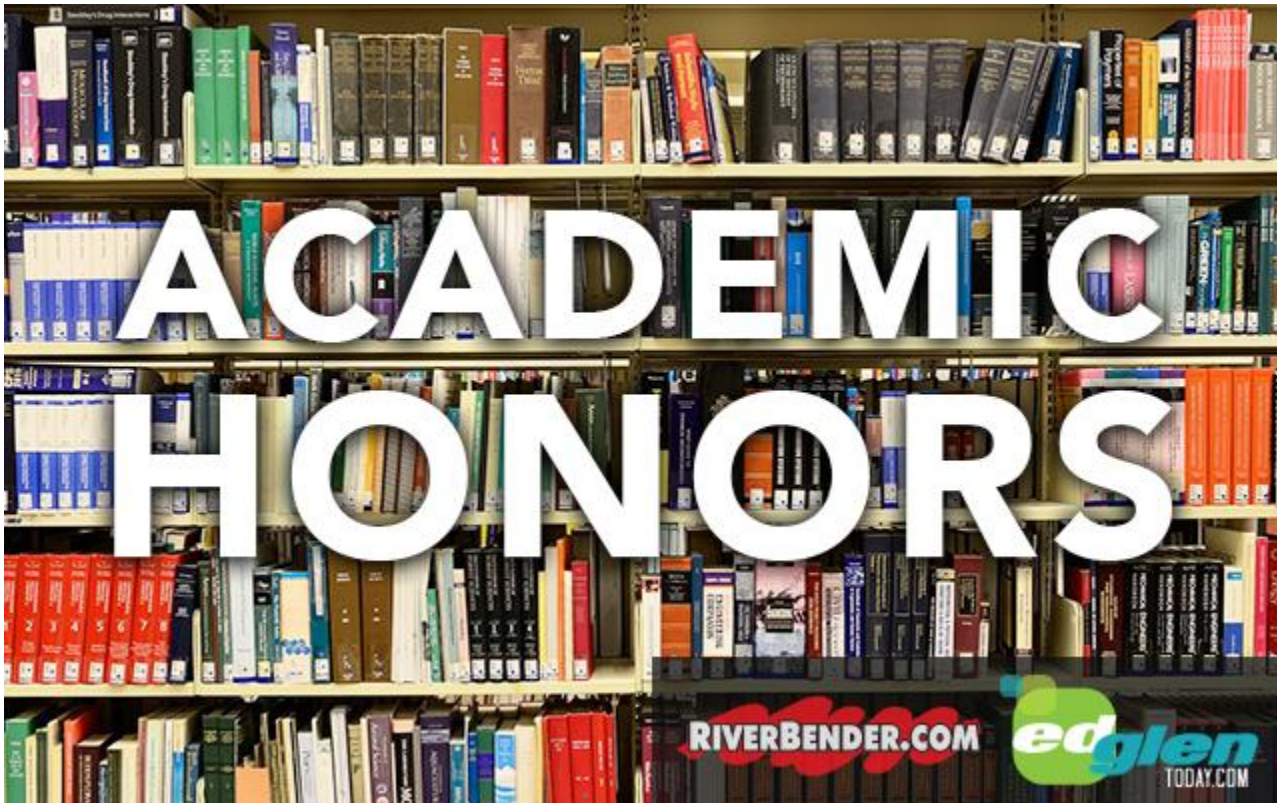




NIU announces Spring 2019 Dean's List
