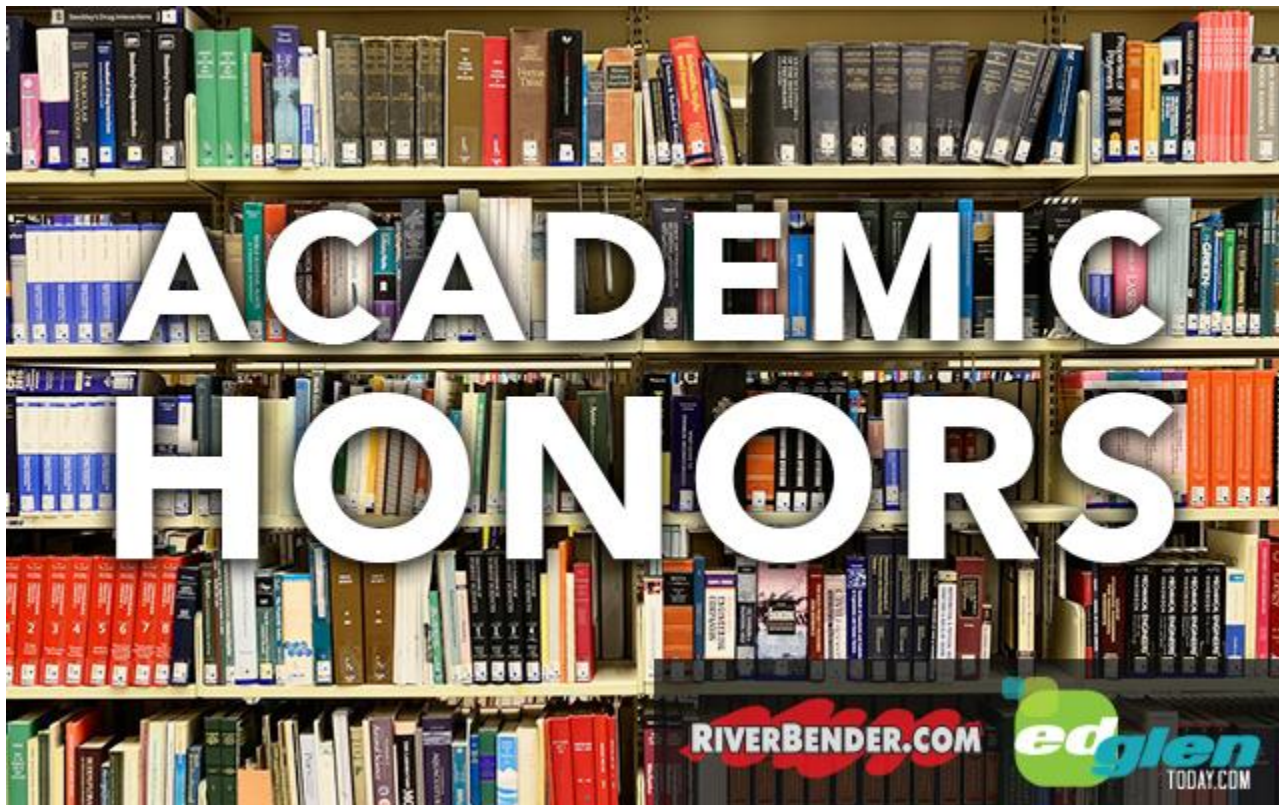




University of Indianapolis Announces Glen Carbon's Madelyn Miller is on Dean's List
