ADULT USE CANNABIS HEALTH ADVISORY COMMITTEE

Tom Hughes will serve on the Adult Use Cannabis Health Advisory Committee. Hughes is currently the Executive Director of the Illinois Public Health Association and has served in this role since July 2013. Before his appointment to this position, he was the Government Affairs Director and Public Health Consultant for IPHA. Hughes has had a long career in state government spanning over 32 years and serving in a variety of capacities including the Deputy Director of the Office of Health Protection at the Illinois Department of Public Health. Charles Watts will serve as an Arbitrator on the Workers' Compensation
