SPRINGFIELD - State Representative Amy Elik (R-Fosterburg) issued the following statement after House Democrats approved an unbalanced state budget scheduled to begin July 1, 2021:

"The late-night antics continue in the Illinois legislature as the Democrats rushed through a state budget with less than 24-hour notice.
