Heartsaver® Courses are for anyone with limited or no medical training who needs to obtain a course completion card for job, regulatory or other requirements. These courses are also designed to meet OSHA requirements.

Heartsaver® classroom courses feature group interaction and hands-on coaching and feedback from an American Heart Association instructor. The course will cover adult,

child and infant CPR and how to prevent choking. The completion card is good for two years.

Classes will be held in the Hospital Auditorium on the following dates in 2015:
