enter the workforce. This program offers in-person classes and training for job skill development, mock interviews, life skills, interpersonal communication, one-on-one job coaching, and pre-employment training.

This donation amount is a direct result of a percentage of gross sales made throughout November 2021. Saint Louis Closet Co. has currently donated \$69,723.09 to multiple local nonprofits.
