

Calhoun on roll after capturing Carrollton Tourney title

Calhoun coach Aaron Baalman couldn't be happier with his girls play at this time with a key win over Civic Memorial in the Carrollton Tourney.

Calhoun beat Civic Memorial 54-44 in the tourney championship game on Saturday. The Carrollton Tourney title victory was the first for Calhoun in five previous attempts.
