



Illinois State Police, Brooklyn Police seek information after body is discovered

At 6 p.m. on Monday, the Illinois State Police was asked to come to a scene by Brooklyn Police Department to investigate a deceased female that was found in an overgrown field.

The body was discovered in a field adjacent to the railroad tracks in the 200 block of South Second St., Brooklyn.

The victim has not been positively identified, Illinois State Police said on Tuesday. The victim was reported to be a black female.
