

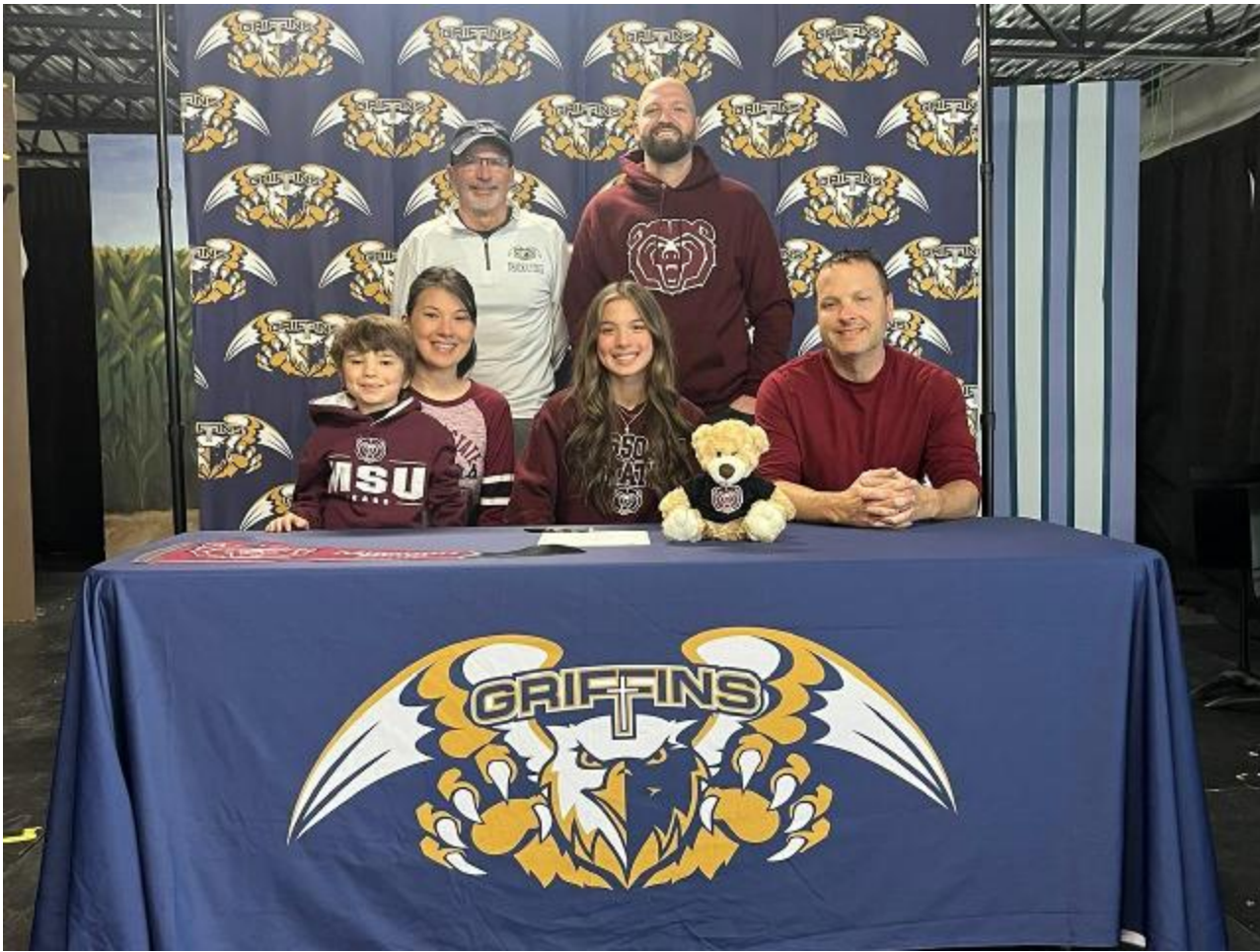


Six Student-Athletes Participate In Father McGivney Catholic Signing Day
