

MEDP to Conduct Survey to Assess Area's Workforce

STAUNTON, IL - The Macoupin Economic Development Partnership has partnered with Ameren to retain Growth Services, Inc., a workforce consultant to conduct a survey of area employers. The goal of the survey is to evaluate the area's workforce from the businesses' perspective. The results will be used to identify and address workforce issues within the region and take steps to assure that the needs of area employers are being met, both now and in the future.

Employers will also find the results beneficial for their own reference. Survey results can serve as a useful tool that enables employers to compare their workforce practices to the aggregate employment base of the area. Selected employers will be asked to provide information about their employee base including wages, salaries, benefits, commuting distances, skill levels and their experiences when hiring new workers. Employers' individual responses will remain confidential.
