The City of Alton, IL is excited to announce the next community planning workshop for the Alton Great Streets project. The team has been busy compiling existing data and identifying an initial list of opportunities for future implementation. The workshop will share these observations and begin to gain initial feedback on these ideas from the community.

The Great Streets project is a comprehensive planning initiative designed to assist the City in outlining a path towards a livable and vibrant downtown with goals of:

- **Improving walkability, wayfinding, safety and connectivity in connecting the downtown districts to each other and to the riverfront,**
- **Enhancing the Alton brand through signage and gateways,**
- **Re-thinking the composition of the Broadway street right-of-way**
- **Strengthening downtown's resiliency and economic development potential**

It is the first of its kind to take place in Illinois; thus serving as a precedent for the process and the outcomes that embody this initiative as championed by East-West Gateway Council of Governments.

The second community planning workshop will be held on Tuesday, January 28, from 6:30 -8:00 p.m. at the Spaulding Club, (formerly KC Hall) at 405 East 4th Street.
