WHAT is accepted: Everything related to computers & electronics, including computer monitors, televisions, household batteries, holiday lights & decorations, phone, a/v equipment, appliances (small & large) and more! Clothes, shoes, toys and linens are also accepted for reuse to needy families.

Paints, tires, household chemicals & furniture are **NOT** accepted.

Drop-off is FREE!

Donations are requested to cover recycling – all donations are tax deductible. Drop-off **ONLY** during designated times.

This event is open to everyone – no residency requirements.

As of January 1, 2012, the Illinois Electronic Products Recycling and Reuse Act makes it illegal for consumers to dispose of electronics in their trash and illegal for Illinois landfills to accept them.
