If your child will be 5 years old on or before September 1, 2013, he/she is eligible to enter Kindergarten. Parent/legal guardian must bring a certified copy of their child's birth certificate, parent photo I.D., health record information, child's social security card, and 2 proofs of residency (see back page for acceptable proofs of residency) to enrollment. Staff will be available to answer any residency questions and/or complete residency affidavits.

A physical is required to enter school, but does not need to be completed prior to enrollment.

Illinois Central Bus will be conducting bus orientation and a short ride for students and parents.

Child must be present for Kindergarten Readiness Skills Inventory. Please allow 30 minutes for this process. ALL students must complete the Kindergarten Readiness Skills Inventory prior to the beginning of the 2013-14 school year. No child will be scheduled for class without completion of the assessment.

Students currently enrolled in the Early Childhood Program DO NOT need to enroll. Readiness Skills will be administered at Early Childhood.

You will be asked to attend a required registration for your child the week of July 29-August 1st. Information will be given at time of enrollment.

Residency Requirements
2013-2014

When registering or enrolling your student(s) during the 2013-2014 school year, all parents/guardians are required to provide a valid driver's license or state I.D. and two (2) proofs of residency. These proofs must be **current (dated within the last 30 days)** and in the parent/guardian's name and with the enrolling address printed on it.

Below are the acceptable forms for proof of residency:

- Utility Bill (water, electric, gas, home phone, cable)
- Sewer Bill
- Trash Bill
- Property Tax Bill
- Lease/Rental Agreement
- Mortgage Payment
- Occupancy Permit
- Public Aid Mediplan Card
- Pay Check or Pay Stub (if address is printed)
- Major Credit Card monthly bill (not random offers to apply)
- Cancelled checks with imprinted name and address
- Installment loan contract from bank
- Residential service contract (e.g., appliance repair, exterminator, window installation)
- Checking or savings account statement
- Insurance policy for home or health
- Vehicle registration card

No general mail will be accepted for registration.

PLEASE NOTE:
