Carl “Hank” Dale Henderson, 82, died at 5:30 a.m. Monday, January 5, 2015 at Rosewood Care Center in Alton. Born December 13, 1932 in Alton, he was the son of Carl L. and Virginia (Roberts) Henderson. Mr. Henderson served in the U.S. Army and earned the Korean Service Medal with three Bronze Service Stars.
