He had been in the forming division for Owens-IL Glass then served in the housekeeping department at Christian Hospital - NE before retiring.

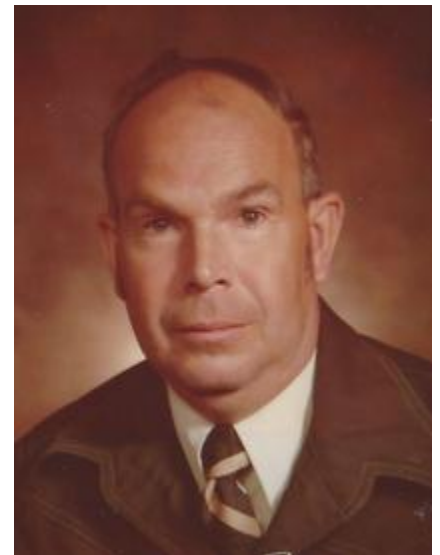
He married the former JoAnn Darnell on June 28, 1963. She died in 2006.
