Daniel C. Pace Sr., 83, died at 10:05 p.m. at his home Saturday April 25, 2015. Born April 1, 1932 in Alton, he was the son of and last surviving child of William Clarence and Arvie (Crick) Pace. Mr. Pace served in the Army during the Korean War and was a lifetime member of the VFW Post 1308.
