Lucille J. Youngberg, 97, passed away 5:55 pm Monday, May 5, 2015 at Oak Terrace Nursing Home in Springfield.

She was born February 16, 1918, in Deer Plain, IL the daughter of the late Vern and Barbara (Arnold) Osborne.

Lucille graduated from Brussels High School and married Philip Youngberg on June 24, 1939 at Sts. Peter and Paul Church in Alton and he preceded her in death on March 31, 2005.

She retired from the Illinois Bell Telephone Co. after thirty-six years of service and was a member of the Telephone Pioneers.



She was the Past President of the Delta Council and served as Secretary for the Delta Life member Club. She was also the Secretary on the Lewis and Clark Foundation Board and won the Alexander Graham Bell Award in 1976 for her community service.
