

Mary Nappier

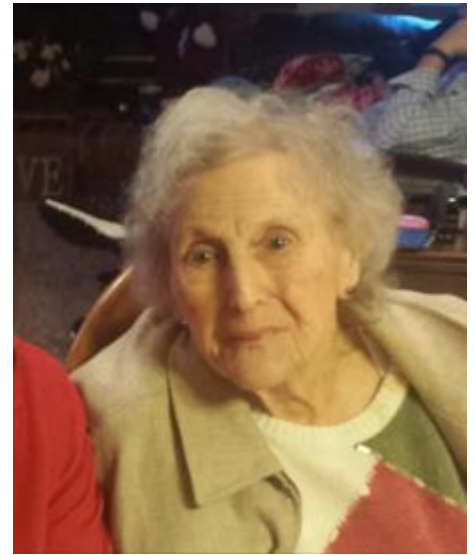
