SPRINGFIELD-David Bruce Crawford, aged 79, formerly of Greenfield, died at 3:35 p. m. Wednesday, July 8, 2015 at St. John's Hospice in Springfield, IL with his family at his side. Bruce was born in Kane, IL on February 15, 1936 to Dual A & Elna (Mowrey) Crawford. He was one of three sons. Raised in Kane, Bruce graduated from Jersey Community High School in 1954. He began his career with the United States Postal Service as a mail carrier and clerk in Jerseyville, IL.
