



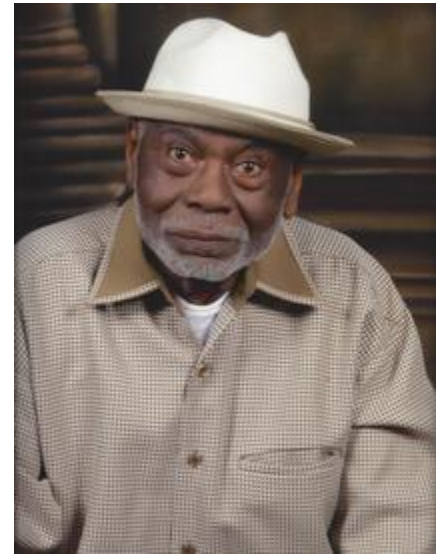
# William Moore
