Kenneth was in the U.S. Army and served during World War II

and the Korean Conflict. He was awarded the Bronze Star Medal for meritorious achievement in ground operations against the enemy in the European Theater of Operations. He served in some of the same areas as his father, Louis served during World War I, including the Argonne Forest and the Rhine River areas in Germany.

He worked for Helmkamp Construction as a truck driver for 15 years and also worked for Stolze Lumber for 27 years.

A funeral procession will leave Paynic Home for Funerals Friday, Oct. 9 at 1 p.m. to arrive at Wanda Cemetery in South Roxana, where he will be laid to rest next to his wife with military honors.
