Maclean Robert Watkins, 90, died at 4:07 a.m. Tuesday, December 1, 2015 at Alton Memorial Hospital. Born July 9, 1925 in Alton, he was the son of Maclean Lawson and Sarah Edith (Miller) Watkins. Mr. Watkins served in the Marines during WWII and was a Purple Heart recipient. He was a member of the VFW Post 1308 and Elm Street Presbyterian Church where he sang in the choir. He played minor league baseball with the Chicago Cubs for the Iona Cubs in Kansas. He enjoyed reading, a glass of Scotch and was an avid Cardinal fan. In 1982 he retired from Laclede Steel as a data processing manager after over 20 years of service. On August 18, 1951 he married the former Doris June Harter in Alton. She
