Richard Eugene Sullivan, Sr., 95, passed away 3:38 p.m. Wednesday, December 2, 2015 at his residence.

Born on February 18, 1920 in Carrollton, he was the son of Alonzo and Myrtle (Milner) Sullivan.

A World War II army veteran, he was an inspector for Cerro Copper and Brass in Sauget for 37 years before retiring in 1982.

On May 31, 1944 in East St. Louis, he married the former Hazel L. "Snookie" Berning. She died October 2, 2006.
