


Georgia Abbott

Georgia Lee Abbott, 83, died at 7:25 a.m., Monday, December 14, 2015 surrounded by her loving family at the Jerseyville Nursing & Rehabilitation Center, under the professional care of Blessing Hospice of Greene County. She was born in Chesterfield, IL. on July 13, 1932, the daughter of the late Willis & Mahala Ann (Taylor) Adams.
