



Lyndal Hawkins

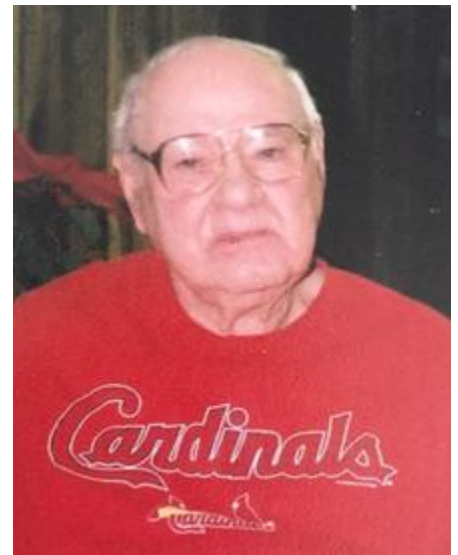
