Paul A. "Red" Stephens, 87, longtime resident of East Alton, passed away 2:30 a.m., Thursday, July 12, 2016 at Barnes-Jewish Hospital in St. Louis.

Born on September 24, 1928 in Brewer, Ark., he was the son of Orville Herman and Martha Belle (Caldwell) Stephens.

A Korean War army veteran, he had been a machinist for the Alton Box Board over 40 years before retiring on May 1, 1988.

On August 27, 1955 in East Alton, he married Sally Ditterline. She died April 23, 2016.

Surviving are a daughter, Paula Blair of Roxana; two grandchildren, Elizabeth Blair (Jere Price), Christian Blair; seven great grandchildren and a great-great grandchild.
