


## **Robert Schudel**

Robert A. Schudel, 84, died at 1:39 p.m. Sunday, July17, 2016 at Alton Memorial Hospital. Born May 5, 1932 in Jerseyville, he was the son of Everette V. and Alice L. (Rice) Schudel.
