Pary W. Moyers, 94, passed away at 10:10 am Thursday, July 21, 2016, at his home. He was born on May 19, 1922, in Carlyle County, Kentucky, the son of Pary M. and Esmerelda (Steinbeck) Moyers. Pary married Virginia Craine in St. Charles, Missouri, on May 9, 1942. She survives. He was a veteran of the United States Army. While serving his country during World War II, between the years 1942 and 1945, Pary was awarded a Purple Heart Medal and a Bronze Star for bravery. Pary was a civil service worker for Granite City Army Depot for 20 years prior to his retirement in 1967. He enjoyed coon hunting and was considered a jack of all trades. Pary was a very loving and devoted husband and father and will be



greatly missed.
