Stephen P. Woelfel, 86, of Michael, IL. passed away Friday June 30, 2017, at Pike County Memorial, Louisiana, Mo.

He is the son of the late John and Clara (Tepen) Woelfel of Hardin, IL. Steve served in the U.S. Navy during the Korean War on board the USS Twining (DD 540) as a Gunners Mate Third Class. Prior to his military years, he worked on the family farm.
