



Thomas Crowder

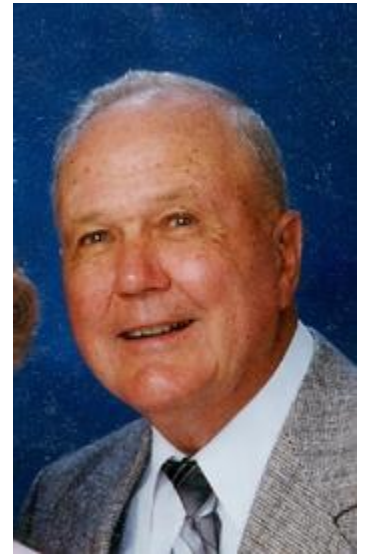
