Herbert Charles Herrmann, 88, formerly of Hardin, died at 9:25 p. m., Wednesday, December 20, 2017 at Jersey Community Hospital in Jerseyville. He was born in Brussels on February 23, 1929, the last surviving of ten children born to Henry and Alma (Kulp) Herrmann. Growing up on the family farm in the Brussels/Golden Eagle area, he learned the value of hard work and self reliance. He served his country admirably with the United States Army during the Korean War. A resident of Hardin for many years, prior to moving to Jerseyville in 1995, Herbert was a well known and respected mechanic at Calhoun County Ford in Hardin, retiring in 1991 after many years of dedicated service.
