Raymond Connell Campbell, 87, died Saturday, June 23, 2018 at Passavant Area Hospital in Jacksonville. He was born in Springfield, Illinois on December 3, 1930, one of six sons born to Ralph and Charlotte (Connell) Campbell. Raymond graduated in 1949 from Bluffs High School, and served for three years with the Illinois National Guard. He retired from the maintenance department at Illinois College in Jacksonville in 1996 after dedicating 17 years of loyal service.
