Ronald Jerome Woelfel, 77, died peacefully at 2:35 p.m., Sunday, August 26, 2018 at Eunice Smith Nursing Home in Alton, after a period of declining health.

He was born in Batchtown on April 16, 1941, the youngest child born to George W. and Rose W. (Tepen) Woelfel.

He was raised in Jerseyville, and attended St. Francis Xavier Catholic Grade School, and graduated in 1959 from Jersey Community High School. He attended Western Illinois University in Macomb on a football and baseball scholarship.

He began working at Olin for a short time, before accepting employment with General Telephone Company. He remained there his entire working career, and was instrumental in their conversion from the analog format to digital format. He retired in 1996 as an equipment operator.
