

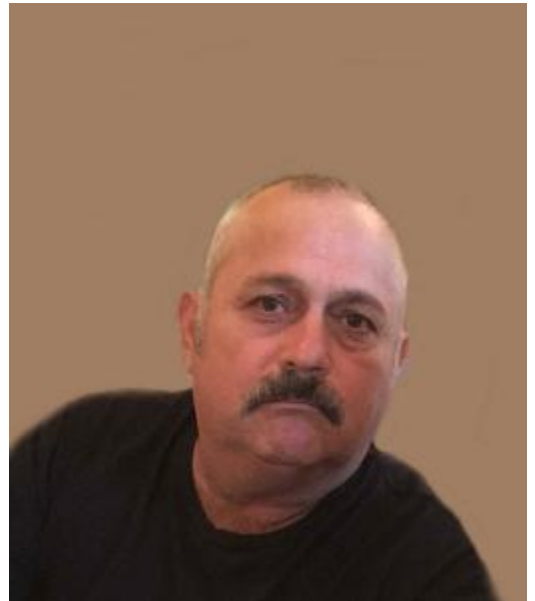


Timothy Loquasto
