

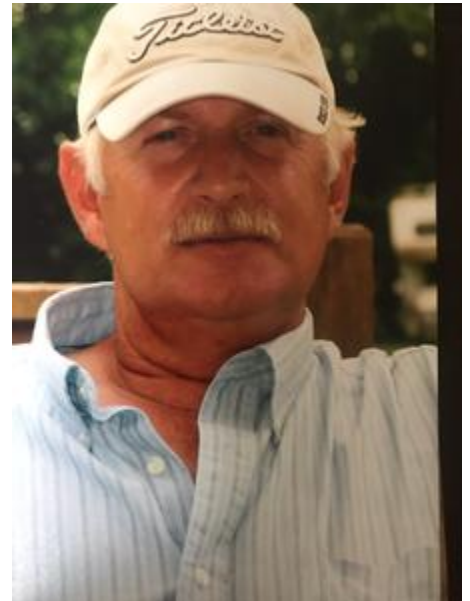


Jason Kraushaar
