



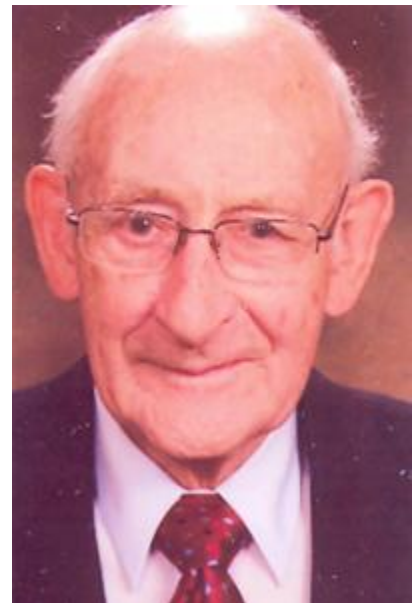
Billy Frost
