



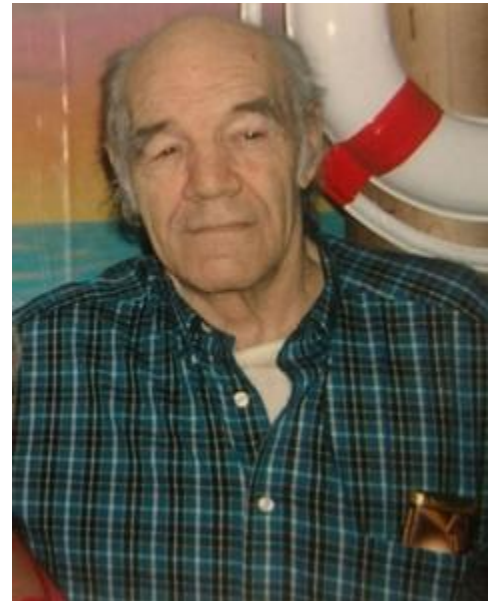
William Bradley
