Floyd Dale Paul, 98, passed away Wednesday, April 1, 2020 at his home in Shipman.

Born Aug. 10, 1921 in Fosterburg, IL, he was a son of Herbert B. and Emma (Voumard) Paul.

He entered the U.S. Army Feb. 2, 1945 and served as a tech sergeant during World War II until his discharge on July 30, 1946.
