Former Wood River resident, Melvin Schoeneweis, 81, passed away February 22, 2019 at his home in Weiser, Idaho.

Born May 24, 1938 in Peoria, the son of Robert and Ethel (Lamm) Schoeneweis, he moved to Wood River in 1947.

Melvin graduated from East Alton-Wood River high School in 1956. Following his graduation, he enlisted in the United States Air Force and served four years.
