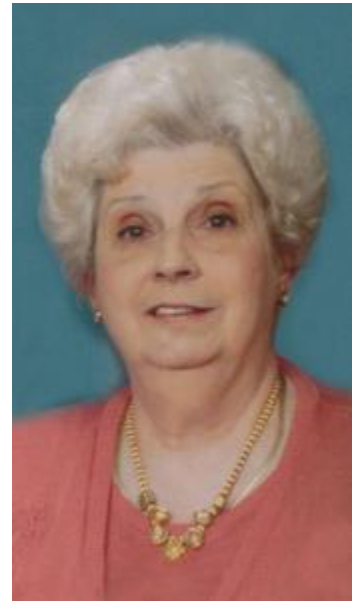

Harriet D. Erwin, 77, died Saturday, April 30, 2022, at Barnes-Jewish Hospital in Saint Louis, Missouri.
