



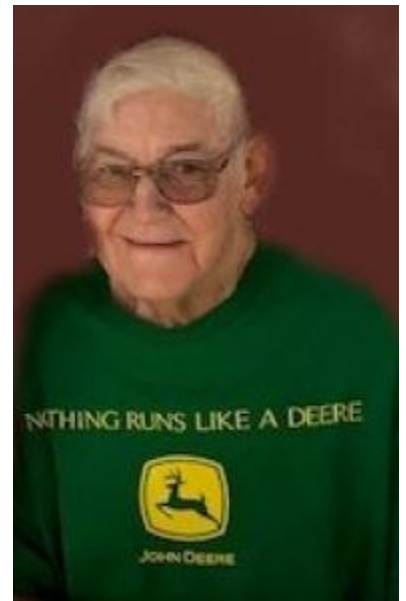
Marlin Schoenbaum
