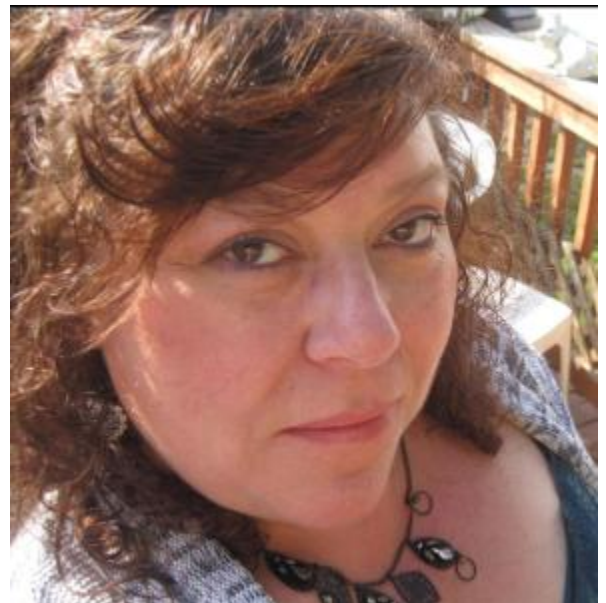
Lynn Etta Cox, 62, passed away unexpectedly, Tuesday, April 23, 2024, at her home in White Hall.
