

## Morris D. "Moe" Stilley

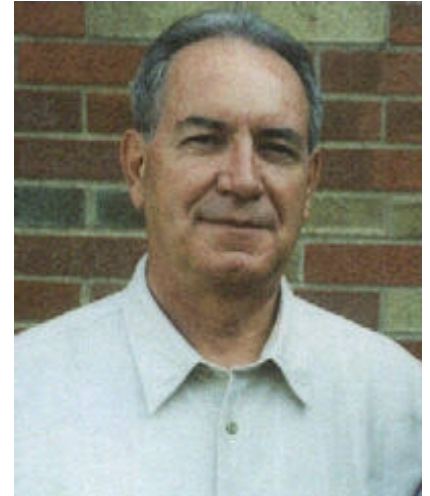
**Bethalto | Wednesday, October 14 2009**
